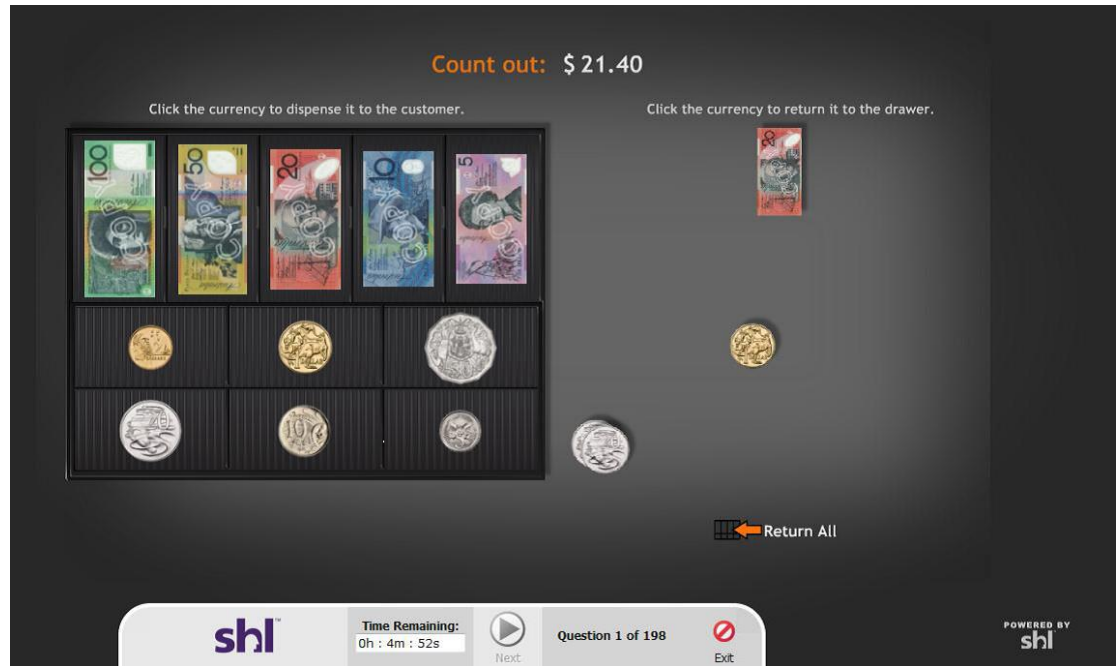

Handling Money: This assessment measures the ability to quickly and accurately perform basic monetary computations to complete customer transactions. This component is characterised by being able to quickly identify and sum the value of various denominations of Australian banknotes and coins.

An interactive cash drawer appears on the left side of the screen. Candidates are asked to count out a specific amount of money to the right side of the screen by clicking on an appropriate combination of banknotes and coins.
