

Verify Following Instructions

Assessment Fact Sheet

Overview

The Verify Following Instructions test measures a candidate's ability to comprehend written rules and apply them correctly. Candidates are given information or rules about different work-related scenarios and asked to apply those rules to answer questions correctly.

This type of test is relevant for use where the following tasks are critical aspects of the job:

- Following rules and guidelines
- Interpreting written information
- Applying rules accurately in the correct situations

This class of test is suitable for a wide range of job types but is especially relevant for entry-level roles.

The Following Instructions test is designed to measure the ability to follow detailed instructions. Scores provide an indication of how an individual will perform when asked to read and comprehend a set of instructions, apply those instructions in different scenarios and make sure every detail of a task is completed according to the plan.
