

## **Verify Working with Information**

## **Assessment Fact Sheet**

## Overview

The Verify Working with Information test measures a candidate's ability to process information. Candidates are given information in different table formats and are asked to use the information provided to answer related questions. Some tables require the candidate to switch between different tabs (see example question).

This type of test is relevant for use where the following tasks are critical aspects of the job:

- Reading information presented in tables and using that information to answer customer queries
- · Combining information from different sources to solve problems
- · Work quickly and accurately

This class of test is suitable for a wide range of job types but is especially relevant for entry-level contact center roles.
